The aims of the day are to:

- ⑤ Create opportunities for Connected Communities heritage projects to share findings, learn about each others' projects and learn from each other;
- ⑤ Create opportunities for Connected Communities heritage projects to work together on areas of common interest;

Range of Activities

We are looking for ideas for contributions in the following formats:

- ⑤ **Papers** should be in the region of 15 minutes plus Q&A/ discussion for 5 minutes (20 minutes in total).
- ⑤ **Workshops and discussion sessions** should bring together participants from a number of CC projects to address a common theme and would be approximately 30 -60 minutes for the discussion.
- ⑤ **Exhibits and posters** will be displayed in the room next to the main symposium

Submission of Expressions of Interest

If you would like to propose a paper/session/exhibit for the event please submit your Expressions of Interest of up to 2 sides of A4 as an e-mail attachment to heritagenetwork@dmu.ac.uk by the deadline 1600hrs on **Friday 18th October** quoting '**SYMPOSIUM and SHOWCASE EOI**' in the subject line.. If you are submitting ideas for more than one session please submit these as separate EOIs attached to separate emails adding 'Proposal 1', 'Proposal 2', etc to the end of the email header.

Expressions of interest should outline:

- ⑤ Lead contact plus names, affiliations and CC projects of all participating presenters and exhibitors.
- ⑤ The key aims of the proposed contribution to the symposium or exhibition in terms of the key themes or issues that the proposed activities would cover, how it builds on or relates to heritage research under Connected Communities, who

within the Programme you hope it will be of interest to and why you believe it would be of interest to that audience;

- ⑤ Please include a draft abstract (250- 300 words) from the paper or short summary of the workshop or discussion session or brief description of the exhibit in the form that it might appear in a delegate pack;
- ⑤ The proposed structure of any proposed session (especially if a break-out or workshop is proposed) (e.g. who will speak, for how long, who will facilitate discussion etc;
- ⑤ The content and format of any proposed exhibit or poster

Please also provide details of any specific practical requirements in terms of space, length of session (see guidelines above), audio-visual equipment etc;
